Please Note** All three forms must be completed and submitted before you will be able to volunteer at Camp Nutimik. All applications will be kept on file. A staff member will contact you by phone upon receiving your complete application.

In order to maintain an excellent environment for campers and staff, volunteers are held accountable to the same standard as our hired staff. While Camp Nutimik does provide job training specific to the work area, volunteers are expected to uphold the job expectations in work ethic and Christian character. In the event a volunteer is unwilling or unable to do their job well, after meeting with their supervisor they may be asked to leave.
