Summer Washrooms Renovation

Construction began on the long awaited "Summer Washroom Facility" in the spring of 1980... and it has stood the test of time. 41 years later it's time for an upgrade!

This spring, Camp will be starting a complete overhaul on the existing Summer Washrooms, converting them to an all-season facility.

Project cost: \$130,000
