Camp Nutimik now operates with a wristband policy. All people arriving onsite MUST have a wristband clearly displayed to access facilities and/or meals. Wristbands are supplied by Camp Management and must be pre-ordered. Exceptions: Employees and their families, those who have made previous arrangements.

CHAPERONES: Camp Nutimik's policy for ALL Children and Youth based groups is a chaperone to student ratio of 1:8. This is a mandatory requirement in all areas of the camp, sleeping, sessions, activities, with no exceptions. This is to help ensure the mental, physical, and spiritual safety of all children while they are on our premises.

Chaperones – Those Teachers/Supervisors who stay with Students at all times (including overnight). Those sleeping apart from Students are **not** considered Chaperones, and will be charged a full Student rate.

** HOTR available to non-food service groups only, unless used as over-flow for larger food service groups.

Kitchen use fee - \$100/day.

In an effort to keep rates low, all groups are responsible to clean the facilities they use, including, but limited to: House on the Rock, Lakeside Hall, all washrooms, and cabins. Cleaning supplies are provided.

Housekeeping is available for \$150/day to clean all washrooms and Lakeside Hall.

HOUSEKEEPING IS NOT AVAILABLE FOR NON-FOOD SERVICE GROUPS.

FOOD SERVICES: Additional Kitchen facilities not available.

Food service groups are responsible for all after meal clean up (Clearing and wiping tables, returning food to kitchen, Stacking chairs, sweeping under tables in dining hall).

DAY RATE – Applies 10 AM TO 10 PM regardless of length of stay – Includes use of grounds and facilities ONLY. Meals are extra – please email for prices.

Archery	\$50
Bicycling	\$50
Canoeing – Lifeguard required	\$50
Kayaking – Lifeguard required	\$50
Swimming – Lifeguard required*	\$50

*Lifeguards have limits to the number of people they can guard at once.

1 Lifeguard = 30 PEOPLE

2 Lifeguards = 75 PEOPLE

3 Lifeguards = 100+ PEOPLE

Chaperones are still required to help with supervision at the waterfront.
